6 ORDINANCE NO. 19 - 2007

8 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A
9 CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS ACCORDING TO LAW FOR THE
10 MAINTENANCE OF THE RADIO SYSTEM, AND DECLARING AN
11 EMERGENCY.

13 WHEREAS, Motorola is the only authorized vendor servicing Motorola radio equipment;
14

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of
16 Summit and State of Ohio:
17

18 Section 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts according
19 to law with Motorola Communications and Electronics, Inc. for the maintenance of the Motorola radio
20 system.

22 Section 2. That the Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for
23 same from funds lawfully appropriated therefor.


25 Section 3. That any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
26 inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or
27 portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been
28 repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.
29

30 Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning
31 and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that
32 all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in
33 meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the
34 Codified Ordinances.

36 Section 5. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for
37 the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga
38 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the
39 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
40 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period
41 allowed by law.
