9 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC  
10 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS,  
11 ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE CHART ROAD WOODWARD CREEK  
12 CULVERT PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

15 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of  
16 Ohio, that:

17  
18 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or  
19 contracts, according to law, for the Chart Road Woodward Creek Culvert Project.  
20

21 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same  
22 from the Storm Water Fund, line item Capital Outlay.  
23

24 Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions  
25 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent  
26 herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.  
27

28 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and  
29 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that  
30 all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,  
31 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent  
32 applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.  
33

34 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the  
35 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga  
36 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that it is immediately necessary to permit timely  
37 and appropriate development of this property, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two  
38 thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force  
39 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in  
40 force at the earliest period allowed by law.
