7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC
8 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS,
9 ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE PURCHASE OF ANNUAL
10 REQUIREMENTS OF CERTAIN SERVICES, MATERIALS AND
11 SUPPLIES FOR USE BY THE SANITATION DIVISION DURING 2013,
12 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
13

14 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of
15 Ohio, that:

17 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or
18 contracts, according to law, for the purchase of the following services, materials and supplies for use in
19 the Sanitation Division during 2013:

- 20
- 21 Wheeled refuse containers
- 22 New Tires
- 23 Retread Tires
- 24 Vehicle & Equipment parts
- 25 Vehicle & Equipment repairs
- 26

27 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same
28 from the Sanitation Fund, line item Other Operations.

30 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
31 inconsistent herewith hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances
32 and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby
33 ratified and confirmed.

35 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
36 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all
37 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in
38 meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the
39 Codified Ordinances.


41 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
42 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls
43 and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members
44 elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and
45 approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by
46 law.
