5 ORDINANCE NO. 2 - 2016

7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO  
8 ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS, ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR  
9 THE REPLACEMENT OR ADJUSTMENT OF CONCRETE SIDEWALKS, DRIVE  
10 APPROACHES AND CURBS AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS IN THE CITY OF  
11 CUYAHOGA FALLS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

13 WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. -2016, a sidewalk and drive approach replacement or  
14 adjustment district was created within the City of Cuyahoga Falls for the purpose of replacing or adjusting  
15 sidewalks, drive approaches and curbs throughout the City;

16  
17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and  
18 State of Ohio, that:

20 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts,  
21 according to law, for replacement or adjustment of concrete sidewalks, drive approaches and curbs at various  
22 locations in the City of Cuyahoga Falls.

23  
24 Section 2. All bids submitted must conform to and be in accordance with the specifications for the same  
25 now on file in the Office of the City Engineer.

26  
27 Section 3. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same from the  
28 Capital Projects Fund, line item Capital Outlay.

29  
30 Section 4. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent  
31 herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not  
32 inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

33  
34 Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the  
35 adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this  
36 Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in  
37 compliance with all legal requirements including, to the extent applicable, Chapter 107 of the Codified  
38 Ordinances.

40 Section 6. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation  
41 of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants  
42 thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or appointed to  
43 Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise,  
44 it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
