8 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A
9 MAINTENANCE SERVICE AGREEMENT FOR THE MULTI-
10 JURISDICTION MOBILE DATA SYSTEM AND CUYAHOGA FALLS
11 OWNED MOBILE DATA HARDWARE AND SOFTWARE SYSTEM
12 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY
13

14 WHEREAS, the Police Department is responsible for the continuing operation of a multi-
15 jurisdiction mobile data system and the system services various police agencies throughout the
16 area, and the cost of maintaining this system is covered by user fees partially paid by those
17 various police agencies.
18

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County
20 of Summit and State of Ohio:
21

22 Section 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a maintenance service
23 agreement for the maintenance of the multi-jurisdiction mobile data system and the Police
24 Department owned mobile data hardware and software.


26 Section 2. That the Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment
27 for same from the General Fund, Police Department, line item Other Operations.


29 Section 3. That any ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
30 inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions
31 not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and
32 confirmed.

34 Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning
35 and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and
36 that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions
37 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter
38 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

40 Section 5. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for
41 the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of
42 Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of
43 two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force
44 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in
45 force at the earliest period allowed by law.
