8 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF
9 PUBLIC SAFETY TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT
10 WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING WITH THE VALLEY
11 FIRE DISTRICT FOR THE SALE OF A FIRE TRUCK NO
12 LONGER NEEDED FOR ANY MUNICIPAL PURPOSE,
13 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

15 WHEREAS, the City owns a 1995 Four-Guys Freightliner tanker truck (VIN
16 #1FV6JLCB6SL636725) that is no longer needed for any municipal purpose, but
17 has trade-in value in excess of \$1,000; and

18
19 WHEREAS, Section 2 of the City Charter, adopted pursuant to Art. XVIII,
20 Section 3 of the Ohio Constitution, authorizes this Council to make exception to
21 competitive bidding and property disposition procedures set forth in the Revised
22 Code,

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of
25 Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

27 Section 1. Notwithstanding and as an exception to Section 721.15 of the
28 Ohio Revised Code, the Director of Public Safety is hereby authorized to enter into a
29 contract without competitive bidding with Valley Fire District, a public agency
30 ("Buyer"), for the sale of a 1995 Four-Guys Freightliner tanker truck (VIN
31 #1FV6JLCB6SL636725), which is hereby declared no longer needed for any
32 municipal purpose, in accordance with the Buyer's proposal dated March 21, 2013.

34 Section 2. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances
35 and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and
36 resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and
37 which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

38
39 Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
40 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open
41 meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its
42 committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public,
43 in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio
44 Revised Code.


47 Section 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure
48 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and
49 welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it
50 receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to
51 Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and
52 approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest
53 period allowed by law.
