5 ORDINANCE NO. 23 - 2016

7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A  
8 CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS, ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE LEASE  
9 AND/OR PURCHASE OF 22 MOBILE DATA TERMINALS FOR USE BY  
10 THE FIRE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

12  
13 WHEREAS, this purchase will allow for more efficient dispatching of safety forces; and

14  
15 WHEREAS, mobile data terminals provide a higher level of firefighter safety incorporating up-to-the  
16 minute information to firefighters in the field; and

17  
18 WHEREAS, the current hardware is old and in need of upgrading to current technological standards.

19  
20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of  
21 Summit and State of Ohio, that:

22  
23 Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts, according to law, for  
24 the lease and/or purchase of 22 mobile data terminals for use by the Fire Department.

25  
26 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same  
27 from the Capital Projects Fund, line item Capital Outlay.

28  
29 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions  
30 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances  
31 and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby  
32 ratified and confirmed.

33  
34 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
35 to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all  
36 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in  
37 meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the  
38 Codified Ordinances.

39  
40 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the  
41 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and  
42 the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected  
43 or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by  
44 the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
