8 AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT
9 BLOCK GRANT ANNUAL ACTION PLAN FOR FISCAL YEAR 2013,
10 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

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13 WHEREAS, Subpart C of Part 91, Title 24 of the Code of Federal Regulations requires that the City
14 submit, as a part of the annual submission of its consolidated plan, an action plan that includes a
15 certification that the consolidated plan is authorized under state and local law and that the City
16 possesses the legal authority to carry out the programs for which it is seeking funding,

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18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of
19 Summit, and State of Ohio, that:

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21 Section 1. The 2013 Community Development Block Grant Annual Action Plan, and the
22 programs contained in the City's consolidated plan, are hereby approved, and the Community
23 Development Department is authorized to carry out the programs contained in these documents.

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25 Section 2. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
26 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent
27 herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

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29 Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
30 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
31 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in
32 meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable,
33 including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

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35 Section 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
36 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls
37 and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that it is immediately necessary to permit timely and
38 appropriate development of this property, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of
39 the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
40 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period
41 allowed by law.
