CITY OF CUYAHOGA FALLS, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. 25

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS, ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE ANNUAL RESURFACING AND/OR REPAIR OF VARIOUS STREETS AS DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT 'A', ATTACHED HERETO, IN THE CITY OF CUYAHOGA FALLS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio:

That the Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts, according to law, for the resurfacing and/or repair of various streets as described in Exhibit "A", attached hereto, in the City of Cuyahoga Falls.

Section 2. That the Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same from the Capital Projects Fund.

That any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that it is immediately necessary to permit timely and appropriate development of this property, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
