7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC
8 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS,
9 ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE REPLACEMENT OR
10 ADJUSTMENT OF CONCRETE SIDEWALKS, DRIVE APPROACHES
11 AND CURBS AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS IN THE CITY OF
12 CUYAHOGA FALLS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

14 WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. -2007, a sidewalk and drive approach replacement
15 or adjustment district was created within the City of Cuyahoga Falls for the purpose of replacing or
16 adjusting sidewalks, drive approaches and curbs throughout the City;

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of
19 Summit and State of Ohio:

21 Section 1. That the Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or
22 contracts, according to law, for replacement or adjustment of concrete sidewalks, drive approaches
23 and curbs at various locations in the City of Cuyahoga Falls.

25 Section 2. That the Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for
26 same from the Capital Projects Fund.

27
28 Section 3. That any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
29 inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or
30 portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been
31 repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

32
33 Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning
34 and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and
35 that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action
36 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107
37 of the Codified Ordinances.



39 Section 5. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for
40 the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga
41 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the
42 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
43 passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest
44 period allowed by law.
