8 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A PIPELINE
9 INITIATIVE GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO HISTORY CONNECTION
10 AND TO INCREASE APPROPRIATIONS AND APPROVE PAYMENT OF GRANT
11 FUNDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

13 WHEREAS, the Ohio History Connection has granted the City a \$4,000 Pipeline Initiative Grant to research
14 and prepare a National Register of Historic Places nomination for the Falls Theater at 2218-2220 Front Street;
15 and
16

17 WHEREAS, this grant will facilitate the National Register of Historic Places nomination of the Falls Theater.
18

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit,
20 and State of Ohio, that:
21

22 Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a Pipeline Initiative Grant Agreement
23 for \$4000.00 with the Ohio History Connection.
24

25 Section 2. The Finance Department is hereby authorized to increase appropriations in the General Fund,
26 Community Development Department, line item Other Operations by \$4,000.00 and to approve payment of
27 grant funds.
28

29 Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent
30 herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have
31 not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.
32

33 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the
34 adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this
35 Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public,
36 in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified
37 Ordinances.

39 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation
40 of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants
41 thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or appointed to
42 Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise
43 it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
