7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE
8 TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS TO PURCHASE
9 FINANCIAL SOFTWARE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

11 WHEREAS, the purchase of this software will integrate with the other software from Sungard
12 HTE, Inc. that has been purchased as part of the eGovernment Project;

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County
15 of Summit and State of Ohio:

17 Section 1. That the Director Finance be and hereby is authorized to enter into a contract or
18 contracts according to law to purchase Financial software from Sungard HTE, Inc..



20 Section 2. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for
21 same from the Capital Projects Fund.



23 Section 3. That any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and
24 resolutions inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and
25 resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have
26 not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

28 Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning
29 and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council
30 and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal
31 action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including
32 Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.



34 Section 5. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for
35 the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of
36 Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of
37 two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force
38 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in
39 force at the earliest period allowed by law.
