5 ORDINANCE NO. 28 - 2007

7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, AS DIRECTOR OF
8 PUBLIC SAFETY, TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR
9 CONTRACTS, ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE PURCHASE OF
10 FOUR (4) HELMET-MOUNTED THERMAL IMAGERS FOR THE
11 FIRE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
12

13 WHEREAS, the purchase of helmet-mounted thermal imagers will ensure prompt location of
14 victims and the sources of fire; and

15 WHEREAS, this equipment will ensure the safety of our firefighters; and

16 WHEREAS, this equipment will ensure preservation of the safety of the inhabitants of
17 Cuyahoga Falls;

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County
19 of Summit and State of Ohio:
20

21 Section 1. That the Mayor, as Director of Public Safety, is hereby authorized to enter into a
22 contract or contracts, according to law, for the purchase of four (4) helmet-mounted thermal
23 imagers for the Fire Department.

25 Section 2. That the Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment
26 for same from the Capital Projects Fund, Fire Department.
27

28 Section 3. That any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and
29 resolutions inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and
30 resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have
31 not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

33 Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning
34 and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council
35 and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal
36 action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including
37 Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.


39 Section 5. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for
40 the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of
41 Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of
42 two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force
43 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in
44 force at the earliest period allowed by law.
