7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF
8 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT
9 A GRANT FROM THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL
10 RESOURCES TO CONDUCT AN URBAN TREE CANOPY
11 ASSESSMENT, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION THEREFOR,
12 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

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14 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and
15 State of Ohio, that:

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17 Section 1. The Director of Community Development is hereby authorized to apply for
18 and accept a grant from the Ohio Department of Natural Resources ("ODNR") to conduct an
19 urban tree canopy assessment and associated tree planting, and to enter into a grant
20 agreement with ODNR governing performance of the grant activities.

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22 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to increase
23 appropriations in the General Fund, Community Development Department, line item Other
24 Operations, in the amount of \$14,000.

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26 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and
27 resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions
28 or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not
29 previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.



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31 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning
32 and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this
33 Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted
34 in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal
35 requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

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37 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for
38 the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of
39 Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided, it receives the affirmative vote of
40 two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force
41 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and
42 be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
