7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO
8 ENTER INTO A MODIFICATION OF CONTRACT NO. 7045 WITH CT
9 CONSULTANTS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

11 WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority of Ord. No. 64-2014, the Director of Public Service entered into
12 Contract No. 7045, with CT Consultants, for the professional design engineering services necessary to proceed
13 with improvements to Howe Avenue from Main Street to Buchholzer Boulevard (the "Project"); and
14

15 WHEREAS, for the Project to proceed, additional surveying services are required to confirm existing
16 property lines, and right-of-way plans and environmental studies need prepared which are required to obtain
17 necessary right-of-way.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and
20 State of Ohio, that:

22 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a modification of Contract No.
23 7045, with CT Consultants, on the basis of its proposal dated March 7, 2016, in an amount not to exceed
24 \$83,657.00. The total contract price after modification as authorized herein shall not exceed \$495,492.00.


26 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same from the
27 Capital Projects Fund, line item Capital Outlay.

29 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent
30 herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not
31 inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

33 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the
34 adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this
35 Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public,
36 in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified
37 Ordinances.

39 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of
40 the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants
41 thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or appointed to
42 Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise
43 it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
