ORDINANCE NO. 29 -2017

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS TO PURCHASE PROPERTY IN CONNECTION WITH THE DICKERSON RUN NATURE PRESERVE PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City has applied for the Clean Ohio Conservation Fund grant which will enable the City to preserve the approximately 40-acre Dickerson Run Nature Preserve, which is nestled along the Haas Road entrance to the Cuyahoga Valley National Park; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) Clean Ohio Conservation Fund grant is highly competitive; and

WHEREAS, by entering into a Real Estate Purchase Contract, the City desires to demonstrate to the OPWC its serious commitment to preserving the property's natural integrity.

NOW, THERFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into a contract or contracts for the purchase of property in connection with the Dickerson Run Nature Preserve Project as described in Exhibit A attached to this ordinance, together with such revisions, additions or amendments as are approved by the Director of Law as being consistent with the objectives and requirements of this ordinance. The amount of the purchase shall not exceed \$1,061,000.00 and is contingent upon the City obtaining and receiving grant funds through the Clean Ohio Conservation Fund.

Section 2. The Mayor, Director of Law, Director of Finance, and other City officials as appropriate, be and are hereby authorized to provide such information and to execute such other actions as are necessary for and incidental to carrying out the requirements of this ordinance and the terms of the Real Estate Purchase Contract.

Any other ordinances and resolutions or portion of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force
