8 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC
9 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT AND/OR CONTRACTS,
10 ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE LEASE AND/OR PURCHASE
11 OF ONE NEW 2006 FULL-EJECT AUTOMATED SIDE-LOADER
12 REFUSE VEHICLE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

13
14 WHEREAS, Ordinance 89-2006 authorized the purchase of a refuse vehicle, and

15
16 WHEREAS, it is advisable to have the option to lease said vehicle.

17
18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County
19 of Summit, and State of Ohio:

20
21 Section 1. That the Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract
22 and/or contracts for the lease and/or purchase of one new 2006 full-eject automated side-loader
23 refuse vehicle for use in the Sanitation Division.

25 Section 2. That the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to make payment for the same
26 from Sanitation Fund, line item Capital.

27
28 Section 3. That any ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
29 inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but only to the extent of such
30 inconsistency, any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not
31 previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

32
33 Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning
34 and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and
35 that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions
36 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter
37 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

39 Section 5. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for
40 the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of
41 Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-
42 thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force
43 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in
44 force at the earliest period allowed by law.
