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20 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of

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23 Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract without
24 competitive bidding with Medical Mutual Services, LLC, on the basis of its final
25 proposals dated November 11, 2013, for the professional services necessary to
26 conduct the administration of the City's self-insured employee medical and dental
27 insurance plans, and for stop-loss insurance coverage related to said plans, for
28 contract periods not to exceed three years.
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30 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to pay approved invoices
31 for work based upon the Contract, from the Self-Insurance Fund.
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33 Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and
34 resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and
35 resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed
36 are hereby ratified and confirmed.
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38 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
39 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open
40 meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its
41 committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the
42 public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable,
43 including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.
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45 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure
46 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and
47 welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, and provided it receives the affirmative vote
48 of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect

49 and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise
50 it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
