7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF
8 PUBLIC SAFETY TO ACCEPT A JUSTICE
9 ASSISTANCE GRANT SUBGRANT FROM THE
10 DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, MAKING AN
11 APPROPRIATION THEREFOR, AND DECLARING AN
12 EMERGENCY.

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14 WHEREAS the State of Ohio through the Department of Public Safety
15 administers financial assistance to employers for the purchase of law
16 enforcement safety equipment, and

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18 WHEREAS the City of Cuyahoga Falls desires financial reimbursement
19 under the Subgrant Program,

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21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of
22 Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

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24 Section 1. The Director of Public Safety is hereby authorized to accept the
25 Justice Assistance Subgrant financial assistance from the Ohio Department of
26 Public Safety, on behalf of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, for the purposes set forth
27 in the grant application and grant agreement.

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29 Section 2. The Director of Public Safety is hereby authorized and directed to
30 enter into agreements that may be necessary to accept the financial assistance
31 mentioned herein.

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33 Section 3. The Director of Finance agrees that it has and will obligate the
34 funds required to satisfactorily complete the project under the terms and
35 conditions of the agreement if the project is accepted for financial assistance.

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37 Section 4. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to
38 increase appropriations in the Law Enforcement Trust Fund, Line Item Capital
39 Outlay, in the amount of \$14,100 and reduce appropriations in Line Item Other
40 Operations by \$8,160.

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42 Section 5. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances
43 and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances
44 and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent
45 herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and
46 confirmed.

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48 Section 6. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
49 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an
50 open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of

51 any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open
52 to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107
53 of the Codified Ordinances.

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55 Section 7. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure
56 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience
57 and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and
58 provided, it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or
59 appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
60 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force
61 at the earliest period allowed by law.
