ORDINANCE NO. 34 - 2014

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 947.05 OF PART NINE, TITLE SEVEN, CHAPTER 947 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES, RELATING TO MEDICAL TRANSPORT SERVICE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit, and State of Ohio, that:

Section 947.05 of Part Nine, Title Seven, Chapter 947 of the Section 1. Cuyahoga Falls Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to provide as follows (new text <u>underlined</u>; deleted text in strikethrough):

947.05 BOARD OF REVIEW.

- A Board of Review is hereby created consisting of three members: (a) one member of Council appointed by the President, the Chairman of the Emergency Medical Services Commission Fire Chief, and the Director of Law. A majority of the members of the Board shall constitute a quorum. The Board shall adopt its own procedural rules and shall keep a record of its transactions.
- Any person dissatisfied with any ruling or decision of the Director (b) of Finance which is made under the authority conferred by this chapter may appeal therefrom to the Board of Review within thirty days from the announcement of such ruling or decision by the Director of Finance by delivering an appeal in writing to the office of the Director of Finance. The Board shall, on hearing have jurisdiction to affirm, reverse or modify any such ruling or decision, or any part thereof.

Section 2. Existing Section 947.05 of Part Nine, Title Seven, Chapter 947Chapter is hereby repealed.

Any ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
