8 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A
9 CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS WITH A FIRM OR FIRMS FOR
10 COMMUNITY CORRECTIONAL SERVICES, AND DECLARING AN
11 EMERGENCY.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of
14 Summit and State of Ohio:

15
16 Section 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract or
17 contracts with a firm or firms for community correctional services.



19 Section 2. That the Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for
20 same first from the Enforcement and Education Fund as appropriate, and if necessary from the
21 General Fund, Police Department, Line Item Other Operations.

23 Section 3. That any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
24 inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or
25 portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been
26 repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

28 Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning
29 and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and
30 that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action
31 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107
32 of the Codified Ordinances.

34 Section 5. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for
35 the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga
36 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the
37 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
38 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period
39 allowed by law.
