7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC  
8 SERVICE TO EXECUTE A MODIFICATION OF CONTRACT NO. 7448  
9 WITH KARVO COMPANIES FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF THE  
10 SANITARY SEWER AND CONCRETE PAVEMENT ON 18<sup>TH</sup> STREET,  
11 FROM OHIO AVENUE TO PHELPS AVENUE, AND DECLARING AN  
12 EMERGENCY.

14 WHEREAS, under the authority of Ordinance 15-2017, the City, after competitive bidding, entered  
15 into contract No. 7448 with Karvo Companies, for the replacement of the sanitary sewer and concrete  
16 pavement on 18<sup>th</sup> Street, from Ohio Avenue to Phelps Avenue; and

17 WHEREAS, it is necessary to replace the waterline within the project limits;

18  
19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of  
20 Summit and State of Ohio, that:

22 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to execute a modification of  
23 Contract No. 7448 with Karvo Companies for the replacement of the sanitary sewer and concrete  
24 pavement in 18<sup>th</sup> Street, from Ohio Avenue to Phelps Avenue, in an estimated amount of \$283,645.00.

27 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same  
28 in an estimated amount of \$283,645.00, from the Water Fund, line item Capital Outlay.



31 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions  
32 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of  
33 ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are  
34 hereby ratified and confirmed.

35  
36 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and  
37 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all  
38 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in  
39 meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including, to the extent  
40 applicable, Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

41  
42 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the  
43 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls  
44 and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members  
45 elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
