7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A
8 CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS, ACCORDING TO LAW, TO ALLOW
9 CLEARWIRE US, LLC, ACCESS TO THE CITY'S WATER TOWER
10 AT INDIAN MOUNTAIN PARK AND PROPERTY, AND DECLARING
11 AN EMERGENCY

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County
14 of Summit and State of Ohio:



16 Section 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts,
17 according to law, to allow Clearwire US, LLC to install equipment, on City Property located at
18 Indian Mountain Park.

20 Section 2. That any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and
21 resolutions inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and
22 resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have
23 not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

25 Section 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning
26 and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council
27 and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal
28 action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including
29 Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

30
31 Section 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for
32 the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of
33 Cuyahoga Falls, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected
34 or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and
35 approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed
36 by law.
