7 AN ORDINANCE TO APPROVE CURRENT REPLACEMENT
8 PAGES TO THE CUYAHOGA FALLS CODIFIED ORDINANCES,
9 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

11 WHEREAS, certain provisions within the Codified Ordinances should be amended to conform
12 with current State law as required by the Ohio Constitution; and

13
14 WHEREAS, various ordinances of a general and permanent nature have been passed by
15 Council which should be included in the Codified Ordinances; and

17 WHEREAS, the City has heretofore entered into a contract with the Walter H. Drane
18 Company to prepare and publish such revision which is before Council;

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County
21 of Summit and State of Ohio:

23 Section 1. That the ordinances of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio, of a general and
24 permanent nature, as revised, recodified, rearranged and consolidated into component codes,
25 titles, chapters and sections within the 2006 Replacement Pages to the Codified Ordinances are
26 hereby approved and adopted.

58 Section 3. The complete text of the sections listed above are set forth in full in the current
59 replacement pages to the Codified Ordinances which are hereby attached to this ordinance as
60 Exhibit A. The listing above of each new section by reference to its title shall constitute sufficient
61 publication of new matter contained therein.

63 Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning
64 and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council
65 and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal
66 action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including
67 Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

69 Section 5. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for
70 the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Municipality and its inhabitants for
71 the reason that there exists an imperative necessity for the earliest publication and distribution of
72 current Replacement Pages to the officials and residents of the Municipality, so as to facilitate
73 administration, daily operation and avoid practical and legal entanglements, and provided that it
74 receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall
75 take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise, it
76 shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.


