7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC
8 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS,
9 ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE STABILIZATION OF HARDY
10 ROAD, BETWEEN NORTHAMPTON ROAD AND THEISS
11 ROAD, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
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14 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and
15 State of Ohio, that:

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17 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or
18 contracts, according to law, for the stabilization of Hardy Road, between Northampton Road
19 and Theiss Road.
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21 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment
22 and increase appropriations in the Storm Drainage Utility Fund, line item Capital Outlay, in
23 the amount of \$269,000.
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25 Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
26 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not
27 inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and
28 confirmed.
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30 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning
31 and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this
32 Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted
33 in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal
34 requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.
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36 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for
37 the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of
38 Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that it is immediately necessary
39 to permit timely and appropriate development of this property, and provided it receives the
40 affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take
41 effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it
42 shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
