6 ORDINANCE NO. 4 - 2007

8 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF  
9 FINANCE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT AND/OR  
10 CONTRACTS WITH NEW WORLD SYSTEMS FOR SOFTWARE  
11 MAINTENANCE AND SUPPORT OF THE PUBLIC SAFETY  
12 AND FINANCE SOFTWARE MODULES, AND DECLARING AN  
13 EMERGENCY.  
14

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,  
16 County of Summit and State of Ohio:

17  
18 Section 1. That the Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a  
19 contract and/or contracts with New World Systems for software maintenance and support of  
20 the Public Safety and Finance software modules and is further authorized and directed to  
21 make payment for same from funds properly appropriated therefor.

23 Section 2. That any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and  
24 resolutions inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances  
25 and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and  
26 which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.  
27

28 Section 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council  
29 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting  
30 of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that  
31 resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all  
32 legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

34 Section 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure  
35 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of  
36 the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the  
37 affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take  
38 effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it  
39 shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
