7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF
8 PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR
9 CONTRACTS, ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE
10 PURCHASE OF ANNUAL REQUIREMENTS OF
11 CERTAIN MATERIALS, SUPPLIES, AND SERVICES
12 FOR USE BY THE GARAGE DIVISION DURING 2014,
13 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
14

15 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of
16 Summit and State of Ohio, that:

18 Section 1. The Director of Public Service ("Director") is hereby authorized to
19 enter into a contract or contracts, according to law, for the purchase of certain
20 materials, supplies and services for use by the Garages Division during 2014, in
21 the following estimated amounts:

23	Fuel	\$950,000.00
24	Tires	\$60,000.00
25	Repairs	\$185,000.00
26	Parts	\$245,000.00

28 Notwithstanding and as an exception to Section 181.06 of the Codified
29 Ordinances, expenditures made under the contracts authorized by this
30 ordinance shall not exceed any of the estimates identified above, unless the
31 Director first notifies ~~the Council President and the Chair of the Finance~~
32 ~~Committee~~, in writing, that one or more of the expenditure estimates identified
33 above will be exceeded.
34

35 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to
36 make payment for same from the Garage Fund, line item Other Operations.
37

38 Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and
39 resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and
40 resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been
41 repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.
42

43 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
44 concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open
45 meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any
46 committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the
47 public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the
48 Codified Ordinances.

50 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure
51 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience

52 and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and
53 provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or
54 appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
55 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force
56 at the earliest period allowed by law.
