5 ORDINANCE NO 4 - 2015

7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC
8 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS,
9 ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE PURCHASE OF ANNUAL
10 REQUIREMENTS OF CERTAIN SERVICES, MATERIALS AND
11 SUPPLIES FOR USE BY THE DIVISION OF SANITATION DURING
12 2015, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

14 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of
15 Ohio, that:

17 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or
18 contracts, according to law, for the purchase of the following services, materials and supplies for use in
19 the Division of Sanitation during 2015:

- 20
- 21 Wheeled refuse containers
- 22 New Tires
- 23 Retread Tires
- 24 Vehicle & Equipment parts
- 25 Vehicle & Equipment repairs
- 26

27 Notwithstanding and as an exception to Section 181.06 of the Codified Ordinances, expenditures
28 made under the contracts authorized by this ordinance shall not exceed, in the aggregate, \$472,400,
29 without further consent of City Council by ordinance or resolution.

30
31 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same
32 from the Sanitation Fund, line item Other Operations.

33
34 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
35 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of
36 ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are
37 hereby ratified and confirmed.

39 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
40 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all
41 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in
42 meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the
43 Codified Ordinances.

45 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
46 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls
47 and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members
48 elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and
49 approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by
50 law.
