9 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PARK AND
10 RECREATION BOARD TO ENTER INTO CONTRACTS
11 WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING FOR THE LEASE
12 AND MAINTENANCE OF GOLF CARTS FOR
13 BROOKLEDGE GOLF CLUB, AND DECLARING AN
14 EMERGENCY.

16 WHEREAS, Section 2 of the City Charter, adopted pursuant to Art. XVIII,
17 Sections 3 and 7 of the Ohio Constitution, authorizes this Council to make exception
18 to the competitive bidding procedures set forth in the Revised Code,
19

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga
21 Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

23 Section 1. The Park and Recreation Board is hereby authorized to enter into a
24 contract without competitive bidding with PNC Equipment Finance, LLC for the lease
25 of not to exceed 76 golf carts for use at Brookledge Golf Club, for a period not to
26 exceed five (5) years.
27

28 Section 2. The Park and Recreation Board is hereby authorized to enter into a
29 contract without competitive bidding with Lake Erie Golf Cars, LLC for the
30 maintenance of not to exceed 76 golf carts used at Brookledge Golf Club, for a period
31 not to exceed five (5) years.

33 Section 3. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make
34 payment for same from the Leisure Time Fund, line item Other Operations.


36 Section 4. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and
37 resolutions inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any
38 ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not
39 inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby
40 ratified and confirmed.
41

42 Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
43 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open
44 meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its
45 committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public,
46 in compliance with all legal requirements including, to the extent applicable, Chapter
47 107 of the Codified Ordinances.


49 Section 6. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure
50 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and
51 welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it
52 receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to
53 Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and
54 approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest
55 period allowed by law.
