ORDINANCE NO. // - 2013

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PARK AND RECREATION BOARD TO ENTER INTO CONTRACTS WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING FOR THE LEASE AND MAINTENANCE OF GOLF CARTS FOR BROOKLEDGE GOLF CLUB, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Section 2 of the City Charter, adopted pursuant to Art. XVIII, Sections 3 and 7 of the Ohio Constitution, authorizes this Council to make exception to the competitive bidding procedures set forth in the Revised Code,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

 <u>Section 1</u>. The Park and Recreation Board is hereby authorized to enter into a contract without competitive bidding with PNC Equipment Finance, LLC for the lease of not to exceed 76 golf carts for use at Brookledge Golf Club, for a period not to exceed five (5) years.

Section 2. The Park and Recreation Board is hereby authorized to enter into a contract without competitive bidding with Lake Erie Golf Cars, LLC for the maintenance of not to exceed 76 golf carts used at Brookledge Golf Club, for a period not to exceed five (5) years.

<u>Section 3</u>. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same from the Leisure Time Fund, line item Other Operations.

<u>Section 4</u>. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including, to the extent applicable, Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

50	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and
51	welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it
52	receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to
53	Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and
