7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC
8 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS WITH
9 GLAUS, PYLE, SCHOMER, BURNS, & DEHAVEN INC., FOR
10 NORTH AMERICAN ELECTRIC RELIABILITY CORPORATION
11 AND SUBSTATION MANAGEMENT CONSULTING SERVICES IN
12 THE ELECTRIC DEPARTMENT DURING 2015, AND DECLARING
13 AN EMERGENCY.

15 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State
16 of Ohio, that:

18 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or
19 contracts with Glaus, Pyle, Schomer, Burns, & Dehaven Inc., dba GPD Group for North American
20 Electric Reliability Corporation and substation management consulting services in the Electric
21 Department during 2015.

23 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for
24 same from the Electric Fund, line items Other Operations.
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26 Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
27 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent
28 herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.
29

30 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning
31 and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and
32 that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions
33 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter
34 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

36 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for
37 the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of
38 Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-
39 thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force
40 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in
41 force at the earliest period allowed by law.
