9 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC
10 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS,
11 ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE REPAIR AND/OR
12 RECONSTRUCTION OF CONCRETE PAVEMENT ON TOWPATH
13 BOULEVARD IN THE CITY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

16 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of
17 Ohio, that:

18
19 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or
20 contracts, according to law, for the repair and/or reconstruction of concrete pavement on Towpath
21 Boulevard.
22

23 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same
24 from the Capital Projects Fund, line item Capital Outlay.
25

26 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
27 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances
28 and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby
29 ratified and confirmed.
30

31 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
32 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that
33 all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
34 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent
35 applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.
36

37 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
38 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga
39 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the
40 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
41 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest
42 period allowed by law.
