8 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TRAFFIC CONTROL FILE BY
9 PROVIDING FOR INSTALLATION OF VARIOUS TRAFFIC CONTROL
10 DEVICES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
11

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of
13 Summit, and State of Ohio:

14
15 Section 1. That, upon the recommendation of the Traffic Committee, the Traffic Control file be
16 and the same is hereby amended as follows:

- 17
- 18 (1) Install an "in street pedestrian crossing sign" at the mid-block crosswalk on 5th Street at
- 19 Redeemer Christian School.
- 20 (2) Install an "in street pedestrian crossing sign" at the mid-block crosswalk on Newberry at
- 21 the Schwebel plant.
- 22

23 Section 2. That the Chief of Police is hereby authorized and directed to note in the Traffic Control
24 file the proper legends.

25
26 Section 3. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to cause the installation or removal
27 of the proper signage reflecting the above amendments.

28
29 Section 4. That any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
30 inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed but any ordinances and resolutions or
31 portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not been previously
32 repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

33
34 Section 5. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
35 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all
36 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in
37 meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the
38 Codified Ordinances.

40 Section 6. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
41 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls
42 and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members
43 elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and
44 approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by
45 law.
