7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF
8 FINANCE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR
9 CONTRACTS, ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE
10 REPLACEMENT OF COMPUTER SERVERS,
11 PROCESSORS, PERSONAL COMPUTERS AND ALL
12 NETWORK AND ASSOCIATED EQUIPMENT, AND
13 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

15 WHEREAS, the replacement of computers and associated equipment is the
16 result of the damage caused by the storm of May 12, 2014, and

17
18 WHEREAS, Vendors will be on state contract and therefore bids will not be
19 obtained.

20
21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of
22 Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

23
24 Section 1. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to enter into a
25 contract or contracts, according to law, for the for the replacement of computer
26 servers, processors, personal computers and all network and associated
27 equipment through a state bid or any other source having a price equal to or
28 lower than that provided by the state bid. Any requirement for competitive
29 bidding is hereby suspended.

30
31 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to
32 make payment for same from the Capital Projects Fund, line item Capital
33 Outlay.

34
35 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances
36 and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances
37 and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent
38 herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and
39 confirmed.

41 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
42 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an
43 open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of
44 any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open
45 to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107
46 of the Codified Ordinances.

47
48 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure
49 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience
50 and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and

51 provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or
52 appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
53 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force
54 at the earliest period allowed by law.
