5 ORDINANCE NO. 49 - 2014

7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC  
8 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS TO  
9 PERFORM EMERGENCY REPAIRS TO VARIOUS ROADS AND  
10 STORM WATER FACILITIES LOCATED THROUGHOUT THE CITY  
11 OF CUYAHOGA FALLS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.  
12

13 WHEREAS, the storm of May 12, 2014 damaged the City's storm water facilities and caused  
14 several roadways in the City to fail or completely wash away; and  
15

16 WHEREAS, due to the emergency nature of the necessary repairs, any requirement for  
17 competitive bidding is hereby suspended.  
18

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of  
20 Summit and State of Ohio, that:  
21

22 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or  
23 contracts without the need for competitive bidding to perform emergency repairs to various roads and  
24 storm water facilities located throughout the City.  
25

26 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same  
27 from the Capital Projects Fund, line item Capital Outlay and Storm Drainage Utility Fund, line item  
28 Capital Outlay.  
29

30 Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions  
31 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent  
32 herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.  
33

34 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and  
35 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that  
36 all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were  
37 in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of  
38 the Codified Ordinances.

40 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the  
41 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga  
42 Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the  
43 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its  
44 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period  
45 allowed by law.
