5 ORDINANCE NO. 5 - 2014

7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF  
8 PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR  
9 CONTRACTS, ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE  
10 REPLACEMENT OR ADJUSTMENT OF CONCRETE  
11 SIDEWALKS, DRIVE APPROACHES AND CURBS AT  
12 VARIOUS LOCATIONS IN THE CITY OF CUYAHOGA  
13 FALLS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

14  
15 WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. -2014, a sidewalk and drive  
16 approach replacement or adjustment district was created within the City of  
17 Cuyahoga Falls for the purpose of replacing or adjusting sidewalks, drive  
18 approaches and curbs throughout the City;

19  
20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga  
21 Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

22  
23 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a  
24 contract or contracts, according to law, for replacement or adjustment of concrete  
25 sidewalks, drive approaches and curbs at various locations in the City of Cuyahoga  
26 Falls.

27  
28 Section 2. All bids submitted must conform to and be in accordance with the  
29 specifications for the same now on file in the Office of the City Engineer.

30  
31 Section 3. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make  
32 payment for same from the Capital Projects Fund.

33  
34 Section 4. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and  
35 resolutions inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any  
36 ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not  
37 inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby  
38 ratified and confirmed.

40 Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council  
41 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open  
42 meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its  
43 committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the  
44 public, in compliance with all legal requirements including, to the extent  
45 applicable, Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

46  
47 Section 6. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure  
48 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and  
49 welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it

50 receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or appointed to  
51 Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and  
52 approval by the Mayor, otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest  
53 period allowed by law.
