ORDINANCE NO. 5/ - 2014

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT TO APPLY FOR AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR THE SUMMIT COUNTY COMMUNITY GRANT FOR THE CREATION OF THE WYOGA LAKE ROAD MULTI-PURPOSE TRAIL PLAN; AUTHORIZING THE PAYMENT OF THE LOCAL SHARE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Ohio & Erie Canalway Coalition requires supporting legislation to apply for the 2014 Summit County Community Grant Program, and

WHEREAS, on October 1, 2013, the Planning Commission recommended that sidewalks or a multi-purpose trail be planned on Wyoga Lake Road within the City of Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio.

WHEREAS, the Wyoga Lake Road multi-purpose trail was included in the City of Cuyahoga Falls CDBG 2014-2015 Annual Action Plan and 2014-2018 Consolidated Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit, and State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Director of Community Development is hereby authorized to submit a \$10,000 grant request to the Ohio & Erie Canalway Coalition for the creation of a multi-purpose trail master plan on Wyoga Lake Road, from Seasons Road to Graham Road.

Section 2. The Director of Community Development, and other City officials, as appropriate are hereby authorized and directed to enter into agreements that may be necessary to apply for and accept the grant mentioned herein, including the expenditure of CDBG funds as a 50% grant match.

 <u>Section 3.</u> Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

 Section 5. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that it is immediately necessary to permit timely and appropriate development of this property, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
