ORDINANCE NO. 52 - 2017

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD TO ENTER INTO CONTRACTS, WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING, FOR THE LEASE AND MAINTENANCE OF GOLF CARTS FOR BROOKLEDGE GOLF CLUB, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, City owned Brookledge Golf Club seeks to replenish its golf cart fleet with eco-friendly, zero-emission golf carts; and

WHEREAS, a reduction of electricity use and conservation will occur with the new golf cart fleet resulting in a cost savings to the City; and

WHEREAS, the City and PNC Equipment Finance, LLC and Lake Erie Golf Cars, LLC desire to enter into a new contract for the lease and maintenance of golf carts which is more cost effective and efficient; and

WHEREAS, Section 2 of the City Charter, adopted pursuant to Art. XVIII, Sections 3 and 7 of the Ohio Constitution, authorizes this Council to make exception to the competitive bidding procedures set forth in the Revised Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Parks and Recreation Board is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts, without competitive bidding, with PNC Equipment Finance, LLC and Lake Erie Golf Cars, LLC for lease and maintenance of 76 golf carts for a period not to exceed six (6) years.

Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same from the Leisure Time Fund, line item Other Operations.

Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its

49 committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public,  
50 in compliance with all legal requirements including, to the extent applicable, Chapter  
51 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

53 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure  
54 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and  
55 welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it  
56 receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to  
57 Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and  
58 approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest  
59 period allowed by law.




