8 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A
9 CONTRACT WITH MEDTRONIC EMERGENCY RESPONSE
10 SYSTEMS FOR THE PURCHASE OF FOUR (4) LIFEPAK 12
11 DEFIBRILLATORS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County
14 of Summit and State of Ohio:

16 Section 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Medtronic
17 Emergency Response Systems for the purchase of four (4) Lifepak 12 defibrillators.


19 Section 2. That the Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment
20 for same from the Capital Projects Fund, line item Capital.

22 Section 3. That any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and
23 resolutions inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and
24 resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have
25 not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.


27 Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning
28 and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council
29 and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal
30 action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including
31 Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

33 Section 5. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for
34 the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of
35 Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of
36 two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force
37 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in
38 force at the earliest period allowed by law.
