ORDINANCE NO. 54 – 2013

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING WITH COASTAL MANAGEMENT, LLC DBA COASTAL STEEL STRUCTURES. FOR THE PURCHASE OF Α PREFABRICATED, UNASSEMBLED STORAGE **METAL** BUILDING, AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS, ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE ASSEMBLY OR CONSTRUCTION OF SAID BUILDING FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE. AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Section 2 of the City Charter, adopted pursuant to Art. XVIII, Sections 3 and 7 of the Ohio Constitution, authorizes this Council to make exception to the competitive bidding procedures set forth in the Revised Code,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

- Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract without competitive bidding with Coastal Steel Management, LLC dba Coastal Steel Structures, for the purchase of a prefabricated, unassembled metal storage building of approximately 15,000 square feet when assembled.
- Section 2. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts, according to law, for the assembly and/or construction of the building referenced in Section 1 hereof, for the Department of Public Service, at 2560 Bailey Road.
- Section 3. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for the contract referenced in Section 1 hereof from the Capital Projects Fund, line item Capital Outlay and for the contract referenced in Section 2 hereof, equally from the Sanitation Fund, line item Capital Outlay, and the Capital Projects Fund, line item Capital Outlay.
 - Section 4. Ordinance No. 49-2012, passed May 14, 2012, is hereby repealed.
- Section 5. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.
- Section 6. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.
