7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF
8 PUBLIC SERVICE TO EXECUTE A MODIFICATION OF
9 CONTRACT NO. 6787 WITH KARVO PAVING COMPANY
10 INC., AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
11

12 WHEREAS, under the authority of Ordinance 63-2012 the City, after competitive
13 bidding, entered into Contract No. 6787 with Karvo Paving Company, for the
14 purposes of constructing the Public Improvements to State Road and Portage Trail;
15 and
16

17 WHEREAS, it is necessary to adjust the scope of work beyond what was originally
18 estimated, due to changes in the development plans for the property, necessitating
19 further work relating to roadways, traffic signalization, lane structure, topographic
20 surveying, and utility verification, which changes will result in a delay in the
21 completion of the project, resulting in additional home office overhead, maintenance
22 of traffic, extended and escalated labor costs and material storage, which will
23 increase the estimated total contract price by an amount not exceeding \$380,000.00.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga
26 Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:
27

28 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to execute a
29 modification of Contract No. 6787 with Karvo Paving Company, authorizing delay
30 costs in an amount not to exceed \$380,000.00 over the original estimated contract
31 price, and allowed modifications pursuant to C.O. §181.06.
32

33 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to pay
34 approved invoices for work based upon the Contract as modified, from the Capital
35 Projects Fund, line item Capital Outlay.

37 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and
38 resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and
39 resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and
40 which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.
41

42 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
43 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open
44 meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its
45 committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public,
46 in compliance with all legal requirements including, to the extent applicable, Chapter
47 107 of the Codified Ordinances.
48

49 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure
50 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and
51 welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it
52 receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to
53 Council, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
