7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF
8 PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR
9 CONTRACTS, ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE DESIGN
10 AND ENGINEERING OF THE DOWNTOWN CIRCULATION
11 PROJECT RELATIVE TO THE RECONSTRUCTION OF THE
12 DOWNTOWN PEDESTRIAN MALL AND ADJACENT
13 STREETS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

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15 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit
16 and State of Ohio, that:

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18 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is authorized to enter into a contract or
19 contracts, according to law, for the design and engineering of the downtown circulation
20 project relative to the reconstruction of the downtown pedestrian mall and adjacent
21 streets.

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23 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to increase appropriations
24 in the Capital Projects Fund, line item Capital Outlay in the amount of \$645,000.00 and
25 to make payment from the same.

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27 Section 3. Any ordinances and resolutions, or portions of ordinances and
28 resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and
29 resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are
30 hereby ratified and confirmed.

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32 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
33 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open
34 meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its
35 committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in
36 compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified
37 Ordinances.

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39 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary
40 for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the
41 City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the
42 affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall
43 take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor;
44 otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
