5 ORDINANCE NO. 56 - 2007

7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC  
8 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS,  
9 ACCORDING TO LAW, TO RELOCATE AND CONSTRUCT A NEW  
10 PUBLIC ROADWAY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

11  
12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of  
13 Summit and State of Ohio:

14  
15 Section 1. That the Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or  
16 contracts, according to law, to relocate and construct a new public roadway in the downtown  
17 central business district.

19 Section 2. That the Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment  
20 for same from the Community Development Block Grant Fund, line item Capital Outlay. The  
21 Director of Finance is further authorized and directed to increase appropriations in the Capital  
22 Projects Fund, line item Capital Outlay, which represents the grant portion provided by the State  
23 of Ohio.

25 Section 3. That any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and  
26 resolutions inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and  
27 resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have  
28 not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

29  
30 Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning  
31 and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council  
32 and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal  
33 action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including  
34 Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.



36 Section 5. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for  
37 the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of  
38 Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided, it receives the affirmative vote of two-  
39 thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force  
40 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in  
41 force at the earliest period allowed by law.
