7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER
8 INTO A CONTRACT WITH MKSK ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR
9 PROFESSIONAL SERVICES TO COMPLETE THE
10 DOWNTOWN AREA CIRCULATION PLAN, AND DECLARING
11 AN EMERGENCY.

13 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and
14 State of Ohio, that:

15
16 Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with MKSK,
17 according to law, for professional services for the Downtown Area Circulation Plan.

18
19 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment
20 from the General Fund, Community Development Department, line item Other Operations
21 and from the CDBG fund, line item Other Operations.

22
23 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and
24 resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions
25 or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not
26 previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

27
28 Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
29 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting
30 of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that
31 resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all
32 legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

33
34 Section 5. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure
35 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of
36 the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided, it receives the
37 affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take
38 effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it
39 shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
