ORDINANCE NO. 60 - 2013

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ISSUE AN ENCROACHMENT PERMIT TO BOSTON BUCKEYE REALTY, LLC FOR THE PURPOSE OF INSTALLING A BUSINESS IDENTIFICATION SIGN IN A PORTION OF STATE ROAD ABUTTING THE PROPERTY AT 1760 STATE ROAD (PARCEL NO. 02-00019), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:


Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to issue an encroachment permit, revocable at the will of Council, to Boston Buckeye Realty, LLC for the purpose of installing, maintaining and removing a business identification sign in a portion of State Road abutting the property at 1760 State Road (Parcel No. 02-00019). The permit shall be substantially in the form now on file with the Clerk in Council File No. 60-2013 and shall contain such terms and conditions as are necessary in the opinion of the Director of Law to protect the public interest.

Section 2. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.


Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

Section 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
