7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC
8 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS FOR
9 THE PURCHASE OF REAL PROPERTY LOCATED ON SIXTH AND
10 SEVENTH STREETS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

12 WHEREAS, the City has received approval of a funds from FEMA to acquire real property to
13 alleviate flooding.

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15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of
16 Summit and State of Ohio:

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18 Section 1. That the Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract
19 and/or contracts according to law for the purchase of the following parcels of real property:

- 20 2846 6th Street, Parcel No. 0203098
- 21 2852 6th Street, Parcel No. 0216196
- 22 2858 6th Street, Parcel No. 0202463
- 23 2851 7th Street, Parcel No. 0210439


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26 Section 2. That the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to make payment for the same
27 from the Storm Drainage Utility Fund.

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29 Section 3. That any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
30 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent
31 herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.



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33 Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning
34 and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and
35 that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
36 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107
37 of the Codified Ordinances.

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39 Section 5. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for
40 the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga
41 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that it is immediately necessary to permit timely and
42 appropriate development of this property, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of
43 the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
44 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period
45 allowed by law.
