15 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

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17 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts,
18 according to law, for the Chestnut Trailhead Parking Lot & Trail Improvements Phase I.
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20 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to increase appropriations in the Community
21 Development Block Grant Fund, line item Capital Outlay by \$71,000 and decrease appropriations in the
22 Community Development Block Grant Fund, line item Other Operations by \$71,000 and to make payment for
23 the same from the Community Development Block Grant Fund, line item Capital Outlay.
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25 Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent
26 herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have
27 not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.
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29 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the
30 adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this
31 Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public,
32 in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified
33 Ordinances.
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35 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation
36 of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants
37 thereof, for the reason that it is immediately necessary to permit timely and appropriate development of this
38 property, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or appointed to
39 Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise
40 it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
