13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of  
14 Summit and State of Ohio:

16 Section 1. That the Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or  
17 contracts, according to law, for replacement of the waterline in 23<sup>rd</sup> Street from Falls Avenue to Broad  
18 Boulevard.  
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
20 Section 2. That the Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for  
21 same from the Water Fund, line item Capital.  
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23 Section 3. That any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions  
24 inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not  
25 inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and  
26 confirmed.  
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

28 Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning  
29 and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and  
30 that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,  
31 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107  
32 of the Codified Ordinances.

34 Section 5. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for  
35 the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga  
36 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that it is immediately necessary to permit timely and  
37 appropriate development of this property, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of  
38 the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its  
39 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period  
40 allowed by law.
