B-65 Presented by the Administration Upon Recommendation of the Planning Commission CITY OF CUYAHOGA FALLS, OHIO ORDINANCE NO. -2013AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A MINOR PLAT FOR A MINOR SUBDIVISION OF LAND AT 2374 AND 2386 SECOND STREET (PARCEL NOS. 02-00787 AND 02-

13215), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Art. VIII, §1.7 of the Charter of the City of Cuyahoga Falls requires that all affirmative decisions made by the Planning Commission be submitted to Council; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has jurisdiction to review and reverse the denial of a Minor Plat Application, pursuant to Section 1113.02(E) of the Codified Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, on September 17, 2013 the Planning Commission approved a Minor Plat consisting of a Minor Subdivision of land (minor subdivision) for Parcel Nos. 02-00787 and 02-13215 at 2374 and 2386 Second Street, in an R-6 Urban Mixed-Density Residential District,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit, and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. This Council approves the Minor Plat Application for a Minor Subdivision of land (minor subdivision) for Parcel Nos. 02-00787 and 02-13215 at 2374 and 2386 Second Street, Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio, as approved by the Planning Commission subject to any and all conditions reflected in File P-25-13-MS and the Codified Ordinances of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, and as depicted in the plan attached hereto as Exhibit "A."

 <u>Section 2.</u> Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.




Figure 1 - Proposed Second Street Elevation




Figure 2 - Proposed Lot Reconfiguration
