Section 1. Notwithstanding and as an exception to the competitive bidding requirements set forth in Title 7 and elsewhere in the Ohio Revised Code, the Parks and Recreation Board and/or Director of Public Service are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with The Cooperative Purchasing Network ("TCPN"), for the purpose of establishing membership in TCPN, and for the further purpose of purchasing products, services, materials and supplies through cooperative purchase agreements administered by TCPN. Competitive bidding requirements which would otherwise be associated with such purchases are hereby waived.

<u>Section 2</u>. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.
